OLD BUSINESS / STANDING ITEMS

- 1) Approve January minutes Approved by Board as written unanimously.
- 2) Financials (Randee) see attached. A volunteer who works at Netflix shared that her husband is a copywriter and is planning to share a note in the company to encourage FF donations for company donation match. Randee shared that the Amazon Smile program has been dropped but we are still getting donations from Benevity and IBM.
- 3) Special visits update (Duane) Visits for April and May are booked solid; will look into the potential to fit in a Pinewood visit in April.
- 4) New site requests remain "on hold" for now, but there are 2 special requests.
 - i) Jail system (Main San Jose jail, Elmwood); email sent previously requesting approval to have discussions.
 - (1) Working on scheduling an in-person meeting to get more information.
 - (2) Bob suggested doing a special visit; not sure of feasibility due to security clearance requirements.
 - (a) Anne put in a request for a security visit (security clearance required). Anne is gathering questions from the FF Board to inquire about during her meeting. Questions / comments noted include:
 - (i) Do they require COVID protocols?
 - (ii) Do not have address or name on dog's tags/collar -just dog's name
 - (iii) What type of animals are they looking for dogs, cats, bunny?
 - (iv) Where would the visits be held?
 - (v) Are there alternate indoor locations?

Anne will come back to the BoD with what she learns.

- ii) Leland High School
 - (1) There was a special visit on 3/13; they expressed interest in having regular visits.
 - (2) We used to have regular visits there; our contact left and visits stopped. Technically they are not a "new" site.
 - (3) We have someone willing to captain, and 3 additional volunteers willing to be on the team.
 - (a) Randee noted in the meeting that we need someone to manage the visits from the school side (not a teacher unless it is during on off-period.) Anne will inquire.

- (b) Also need to determine who should be the Captain Loree was the past Captain or should it be the person noted in #3 above who is willing to captain? Board needs to determine if we proceed with the visit

 - i) Tara proposed and the Board agreed to move volunteers whose dogs are outdated by more than a year to "retired" status and thereby removed from active lists.
 - ii. Volunteers who continually sign up for events and cancel at the last minute
 - i) Duane took the action to send a note to Dorothy Parish to discuss her ongoing engagement on special visits.

- 7) Thanks to Randee for arranging for Pup Plaza class location


- 8) Next meeting:


